I am directed to refer to letter No.A.D.(Legal)BSP/ 4(31)/2022/1133 dated the 22nd August, 2022 alongwith its enclosures, received from the Directorate General, Bureau of Supply & Prices, Government of Sindh, on the subject noted above, which is s elf-explanatory.

In the enclosed letter, the Administrative Department highlighted various laws legislated by the Provincial Legislature with respect to Weight and Measures, Registration of Godowns and Consumer Protection. The delinquents / violators of such laws and the cases there-against are tried by the respective Civil Judges and Judicial Magistrates, nominated by the Learned District & Sessions Judge vide Order No.E/O/22(43) of 2011 dated 12.12.2011, whereas a cluster different nature of cases already being tried by these Judicial Officers.

The Administrative Department further contended in his letter that there are 29 Consumer Protection Courts at District level in the Province have been established for hearing the matters for protection of consumers' rights and their redressal. As per contention of the Department, at present, there is very low number of complaints is available before these Courts for proceeding, therefore, the Department has requested for assigning the jurisdiction of the matters pertaining to the violation and violators of the Sindh Standard Weights and Measures (Enforcement) Act, 1975 and the Sindh Registration of Godowns Act, 1995, to the Consumer Courts for their proceedings by the concerned Presiding Officers in the interest of general public.

In the wake of above, the request of the Administrative Department may be considered and if found tangible, may be recommended and placed before his Lordship (Hon'ble Chief Justice of High Court of Sindh).

SUBJECT:- ASSIGN JURISDICTION TO THE DISTRICT CONSUMER PROTECTION COURT (S) FOR PROSECUTION AGAINST VOILATORS OF THE SINDH STANDARD WEIGHTS AND MEASURES ENFORCEMENT ACT, 4975 AND

THE SINDH REGISTRATION OF GODOWNS ACT, 1995.

I am directed to refer to the subject noted above and to inform that the august Provincial Assembly of Sindh has enacted following enactments for enforcement of different functions and purposes to provide necessary relief to the consumers:-

1. The Sindh Standard Weights and Measures (Enforcement) Act, 1975;

2. The Sindh Registration of Godowns Act, 1995.

It is further informed that there is analogous provision in above enactments for prosecution against their delinquent(s). These delinquent (s) are prosecuted by the learned Civil Judge & Judicial Magistrate (s), nominated by the Hon'ble District & Sessions Judge of respective district as per past practice. Whereas, there are already cluster of different nature of cases being tried by learned Civil Judge & Judicial Magistrate (s). The Hon'ble District & Sessions Judge, Hyderabad vide Order No.E/O/22/(43) of 2011 dated 12.12.2011, has nominated the Judicial Magistrate-VIII, Hyderabad (Annex-I).

It is pertinent to mention that the Govt. of Sindh through the Provincial Assembly of Sindh has enacted the Sindh Consumer Protection Act, 2014 for protection of consumers' rights and redressal of their grievances. In pursuance of above enactment, the Govt. of Sindh has established 29 District Consumer Protection Courts at district level in Sindh for prosecution against violators of above said Act vide Notification dated 10.01.2019 (Annex-II). These courts are functional and are providing relief to the consumers. However, at present no significant number of complaints is received and processed by these courts.

For quick disposal of under trial cases against violators of the Sindh Standard Weights and Measures Enforcement Act, 1975 and the Sindh Registration of Godowns Act 1995, the Presiding Officer (s), District Consumer Protection Court of their respective district may be assigned jurisdictions of above enactments.

It is, therefore, requested to approach the learned Registrar, High Court of Sindh, Karachi with request to recommend above proposal to the Hon'ble Chief Justice, High Court of Sindh to assign jurisdiction of above enactments to the Presiding Officer (s), District Consumer Protection Court for speedy trial and quick disposal.


